From the Principal:

What a busy start to the year!! We have five Kindy students who have started their school journey with us and five students in Room 1 who are new to the school. That makes a total of ten new students!!

Our teachers in Room 1 for term 1 are Mrs Niki Crane three days per week, and Mrs Sue Wilson two days per week. Ms Amy Nelson is taking the Kindy students on Tuesdays and Thursdays this term. We are advertising for a full time teacher from Term 2 as we were unable to fill the position last year due to the late notification that Sara Sills had been appointed to Brabham Primary. We wish her all the best as she embarks on the next phase of her journey. Ms Cathy Harman is our EA two days a week, and Mrs Alicia Guy is kindly filling in the other three days a week. Welcome to you Alicia.

The shipping container has been delivered and our thanks go to the P & C for funding this. It has provided much needed space for storage of the ECE equipment. We are going to re-locate it to be closer to the teaching block for ease of access.

The Athletics carnival is being held on the 8th March at the Cascade oval. We will need parent help to set up the shade gazebos. I will be heading to Cascade very early in the day to set up the games and organise all the other tasks that need to be completed. We commenced our training for the carnival last week. Cascade PS will be joining us for practice for a couple of weeks then we will go by bus to the cascade oval for practice on Tuesday 5/3/24.

The Year 5/6 Mallee Schools camp planning is underway with approximately 40 students and four staff indicating they would like to participate. At this stage we will be travelling to Perth by coach on Sunday 9/6 and returning to school on Friday 14/6 by coach. The camp will be held at Swan Valley Adventure camp where students will participate in physical challenges, team building and water based activities. We are the organising school this year.

The Performing Arts being delivered at Hopetoun PS will commenced last Wednesday. Students travel by bus to Hopetoun where they participate in the performing arts classes as well as some lessons at their year level. This is a program that will run for the year and will culminate with a

First Day of Kindy




I loved Pancake Tuesday. It was so fun. We made pancakes and we ate them. Lincoln




